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| 7:45 – 8:30 am   | <b>Breakfast</b><br>We provide a light breakfast and then usher participants to the main auditorium to register. We urge all schools to arrive as early as possible.   |
| 8:30 – 9:00 am   | <b>Registration and Morning Entertainment</b><br>Faculty advisors will register their schools as they enter the main auditorium. An emcee and various student groups from around the state keep participants entertained as we get closer to starting the day's events.  |
| 9:00 – 10:00 am  | <b>Opening Ceremonies</b><br>Each year our Executive Committee selects a notable keynote speaker with an inspiring message related to diversity. We also award the Conference Scholarship to one student.  |
| 10:10 – 11:45 am | <b>Discussion Groups &amp; Lunch</b><br>Students join a discussion group to talk about diversity issues with students from across the state. Past topics included cliques, peer pressure, and harassment. Meanwhile, faculty advisors gather to have their own discussion on diversity issues and teaching techniques. |
| 12:00 – 1:15 pm  | <b>Workshop A</b><br>Both students and faculty advisors attend a workshop of their choice. Workshops focus on a variety of themes, including gender, class and poverty, race and ethnicity, sexual orientation, mental and physical challenges, history, and conflict resolution.                                      |
| 1:25 – 2:40 pm   | <b>Workshop B</b><br>Everyone attends a second workshop of their choice.   |
| 2:50 – 3:20 pm   | <b>School Meetings</b><br>This time is devoted to schools discussing as a group how to incorporate what they've learned at the conference into their own communities.  |
| 3:30 – 4:00 pm   | <b>Closing Ceremonies</b><br>We finish our day with another performance, a video montage of the day's events, and the awarding of the Human Rights Award to one group or individual in the community.  |
